Latest feedback from the Food Bank is that they are extremely short of chocolates, sweets (treats for children), sponge puddings (they have enough rice puddings), long life cake, long life fruit juice, jam, ketchup, cooking oil. Other items are always welcome but they are short of these for the time being.

At the moment they are not short of breakfast cereals, beans, tea bags or pasta.
