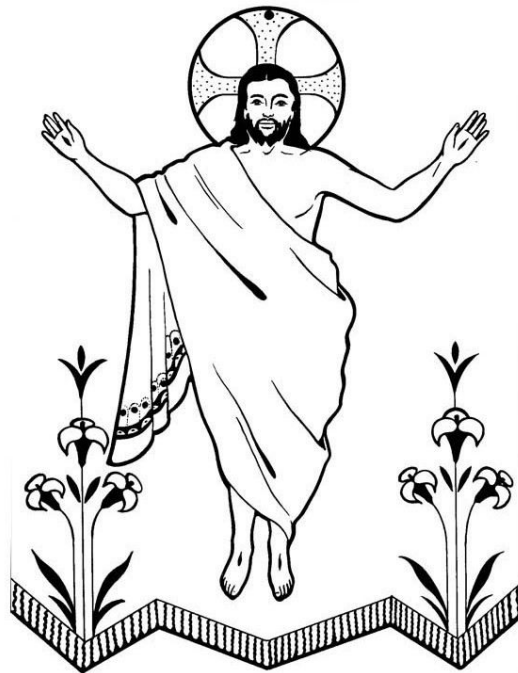

Eucharistic Adoration St Paul's

Please note that there will be no Eucharistic Adoration at St Paul's on this Wednesday 24 April. We will resume after Easter on Wednesday 1 May.

To be able to do this, the parish is undertaking a census of all those who attend St Paul's and St Brigid's Churches to provide us with a full and comprehensive Parish Register. It has been too many years since our records were amended and is now sadly out of date. Over the next few weeks blank cards will be available for you to complete. These cards require your:

Name, date of birth, address, email, mobile, landline number, and your parish. On the reverse of the card we ask details of: - Names and dates of birth of any other adults and young people (under 18) who live at your address.

We would ask you to post your completed card in the box at the back of the Church, so that we can begin to formulate our New Parish Register. We will fully comply with the Data Protection Act and no information will be passed on. By giving us this information you are agreeing for us to store your details in a secure place.
